

## **Evacuation Kit**

- Clothes/shoes for at least 5 days. Include seasonal/rain gear
- Prescription Medicine (bottles as well as pill box)
- Non Prescription Meds( Tylenol, Anti-diarrhea, allergy, Beano, Eye drops, vitamins
- Toiletries: deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, cologne, body wash/soap, razor, shampoo, wipes, anti-bacterial hand soap, etc.
- Glasses and sunglasses
- Jewelry, coins and other valuables
- Purse, billfold, Cash (including small bills as ATM's may not be open or available for extended periods of time after a catastrophic event)
- Credit and Debit cards ,Checkbooks, extra checks and due bills
- Passport and password book
- Cell phone, Tablet, Laptop and chargers and portable battery chargers,
- Battery operated radio, Ham radio and NOAA weather radio with extra batteries. Flashlight with extra batteries
- Food, bottled water, coffee, tea and snacks for a week with cooler and ice packs. Can opener, utensils and paper products. Special dietary foods
- "To Go" folder of important documents. To include: Home owners insurance, car insurance, Life insurance, Will and Power of Attorney, medical records and health insurance, bank account numbers
- First aid kit and bag of tools
- Guns and ammo
- Re-entry tag and map of the area
- Books, cards, games
- Bag for dirty laundry
- Gas cans
- Photo albums and any remaining valuables to dishwasher
- Additional items for going to a shelter
  - Air mattress and pillow
  - Sleeping bag and/or set of sheets
  - Hand sanitizer and/or disinfecting wipes
  - Toilet paper and paper towels
  - Battery operated fan
